Dear Parents,

It is school time again! We are very excited to have your child at Daffodils and want to personally thank you for sharing your child with us. We believe that by working together we can make this a very successful year.

## School Year Bits and Pieces:

● **Late Arrivals** distract other children and your child may find it difficult to participate in daily activities due to frequent absences.

\*Please do not bring your child to school later than 8:45am

● **Car Pool:** Please use car pool at pick-up and drop-off times: 8:20am to 8:35am and 2:50pm to 3:05pm. Please refer back to the parent handbook for Carpool Guidelines. Please do not drop off school day children before 8:20am in the morning and do not pick them up later than 3:05pm in the afternoons. It is Important you pick up your "ON TIME" as our teachers need to leave at a certain time.

● **Birthdays:** Please do not send cupcakes, cake, candy, or any other high sugar items for birthday celebrations. You are welcome to send fresh fruit and or cheese platters. **Please notify your child's teacher in advance if you would like to come in and celebrate your child's birthday.**

● **Lunches:** We do not allow processed junk foods, candy, high sugar foods, or any sort of peanut products at school. **Please refer back to the Parent Handbook about more details.**

● **Dress Code:** The school does not require a uniform. Children need to wear comfortable clothing. We suggest rubber soled shoes, tennis or oxfords. If your child is clean well groomed he/she has a better attitude towards school. Please ensure your child is not dressed in costume (Elsa, Spiderman, Barbie etc.) as it can be distracting to the class. Also, please bring an extra change of clothes and label everything.

● **Sick Note:** If your child is sent home with a Sick Note please pay close attention to checked box on the note.

-Your child must be free of any and all contiguous illnesses/disease and fever free for **24 hours** before returning to school.

- If your child is sent home for vomiting or diarrhea your child must be free of either or for **24 hours** before returning to school.

-If your child has been diagnosed/exposed to any contiguous illness/disease the school must be notified.

● **Toys:** We have a strict policy against any sort of toys, stuffed/plush, battery-operated toy or action figure etc. Please do not send any toys or battery-operated toys to school. They will be confiscated by the office and parents will have to pick it up at the end of the day.

● **Immunizations:** This is a good time of year to give us a copy of your child's vaccination record.

● **Medications:** If your child needs medication please bring it to the office and sign the medication log. The office staff is responsible for giving your child the medication as prescribed on the label.
